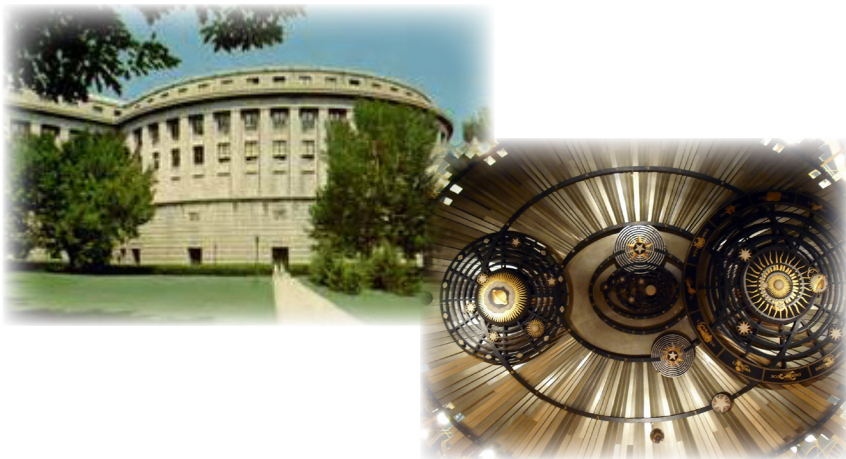
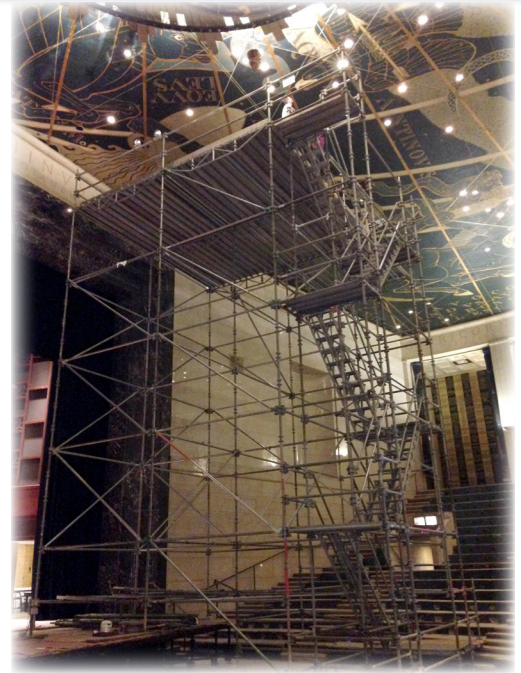


Forum Building

RLS Construction Group was selected by the Pennsylvania Department of General Services to provide interior and exterior construction services at the historic Forum Building in Harrisburg. The 1,800-seat auditorium, built in 1931, underwent a major rehabilitation effort to upgrade and preserve this valuable public venue. The exterior work included repair and replacement of the entrance concourse and surrounding public walkways, and the repair and upgrade of the vehicular loading ramps on the building's south side. The interior work involved conservation of the historic murals on the ceiling and walls, including structural and mechanical upgrades that will prevent future damage. Additional work included preservation and repair of the auditorium flooring, replacement of the seating, and installation of new floor lighting. The completed work ensures that future generations will continue to enjoy this unique architectural gem.
