

# Fort Detrick National Gateway Center

**RLS Construction Group** was contracted by the Department of the Army, to perform tasks associated with renovations to the National Gateway Center, Building #1671, to refresh the facility for future uses. The project included work in multiple rooms of the building, with various start and completion date requirements. The specific tasks consisted of demolition, including the removal of existing electrical systems, data-communications systems, ductwork, flooring, base molding, doors/frames, ceiling, lighting, cabinets, sinks, and counter-tops. Additionally, the work involved installation and new construction consisting of electrical systems, data-communications systems, fire alarm systems, ductwork, framing, insulation, wallboard/molding, doors/frames, ceiling, lighting, painting, cabinets, sinks, and counter-tops. RLS was required to patch and repair any remaining surfaces to create a fresh appearance and modern aesthetic for the building. Special considerations on this project were the potential for asbestos and hazardous materials in the areas affected by the renovations, as well as the strict security protocols in place, because the project is located on an active military base.
