

Philadelphia VA Medical Center Building #2 - Main Entrance

RLS Construction Group was contracted by the Department of Veterans Affairs to replace the main entrance at Building #2, on the Philadelphia VA Medical Center campus, in Philadelphia, PA. The work involves removal of the existing structure, including disconnecting the electrical system, modifying the sprinkler system, and preparing the area for the updated entrance. The finished entrance will feature a new door, ceiling, flooring, tempered and insulated glass, updated sidelights, and new trim work that will match the existing architectural finishes. An important consideration for this project is minimizing disruptions to Building #2's function during construction. Therefore the project site will be restricted from the main lobby, a temporary entrance will be established, and the work will be performed over the weekend to reduce interference for staff at the facility.
