3. Description of Supplies or Services: Ball Valves manufactured by "Apollo Conbraco". This Ball Valve is facility standards. The facility stocks and maintains Apollo Conbraco valves only. These valves are installed throughout the hospital and considered to be a "Higher Quality" which provides better operations and less down time. Therefore any other valve would not work as a substitute and be substantial duplication of cost.
